## First Delivery of AltaiCare Appliance

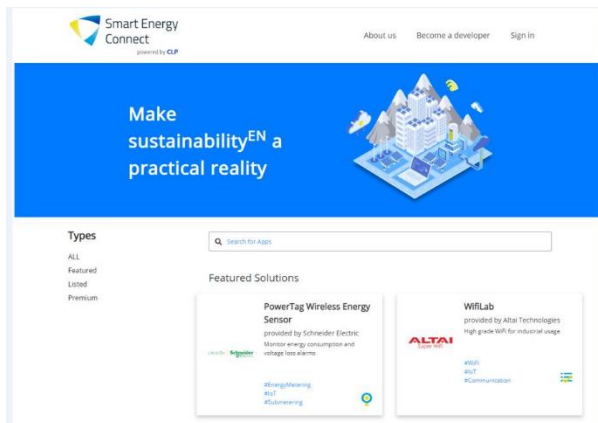
