Altai Participates in Mask Distribution to Fight Coronavirus

Dr. Raymond Leung, the chairman and CEO of Altai Technologies, the world's leading supplier of outdoor WiFi products, is also the chairman of Give2Asia Foundation Limited, Hong Kong, a nonprofit organization works with local charities.



In regard of the coronavirus outbreak, Give2Asia purchased an amount of 400,000 masks for distribution to hospitals and NGOs in Hong Kong and Mainland China. Altai's Dry Port Solution for CONCOR

Once again, Container Corporation of India Ltd. At least thousands of containers are densely stacked at the height of five containers.



Since standard access points are not suitable for deployment in container yard due to signal blockage by cranes and container stacking, Altai's A8n(ac) Wi-Fi base-stations, A2 bridges and Access Controller have been used at different locations with redundant coverage for large area coverage and network management.

Altai's New Project with Sonatel in Guinea

Altai has signed up a new partner, Sonatel, in Senegal to take care of its business in West African region. Sonatel is the principal telecommunications service provider in Senegal and is majority owned by the French multinational telecommunications corporation, Orange.
